59 Skeet Shooters attended the 3rd consecutive running of the Zeljko Bacani Memorial 100 Target Skeet Championship at FACTC on Sunday 17 April. Conditions were clear with some nice warmth in the brightly shining sun!

The day was combined with a Cancer Council of Victoria Fundraiser with \$20 from each nomination being donated as well as all proceeds from a raffle. \$2273 was raised on the day which was \$240 more than the monies raised in 2015! What a great contribution to such a worthy cause.

Leigh Roberts continued his fine form from the Victorian State Skeet Carnival in January and took out the Overall with the only one to shoot a perfect 100/100.

Mark McDonald and Jack Stockdale were one target down and went into a shoot off for 1st and 2nd in AA with Mark claiming victory with a further 10/14 in the doubles shoot off to finish with 109/114 and Jack in 2nd place with 108/114.

Mike Corbett and Jim Kalaboukas entered a shoot off for 1st and 2nd in A grade with Jim missing 1 target from the first pair and claiming 2nd place with 97/102. Mike took 1st in A Grade with 98/102.

Jack Bird won B Grade outright with 97/100 and Simon Hewitt in 2nd with 95/100. Some great C Grade shooting with Mike Stokes in 1st place with 89/100 and Andrew Watson not far behind in 2nd place with 86/100.

Bruno Scalise won Juniors with 65/100. Renae Birgan, only 2 targets ahead of Jacqui Durham, won Ladies with 93/100 and Max Oakley defeated Mike Corbett in a shoot off to take out Veterans with 100/104.
